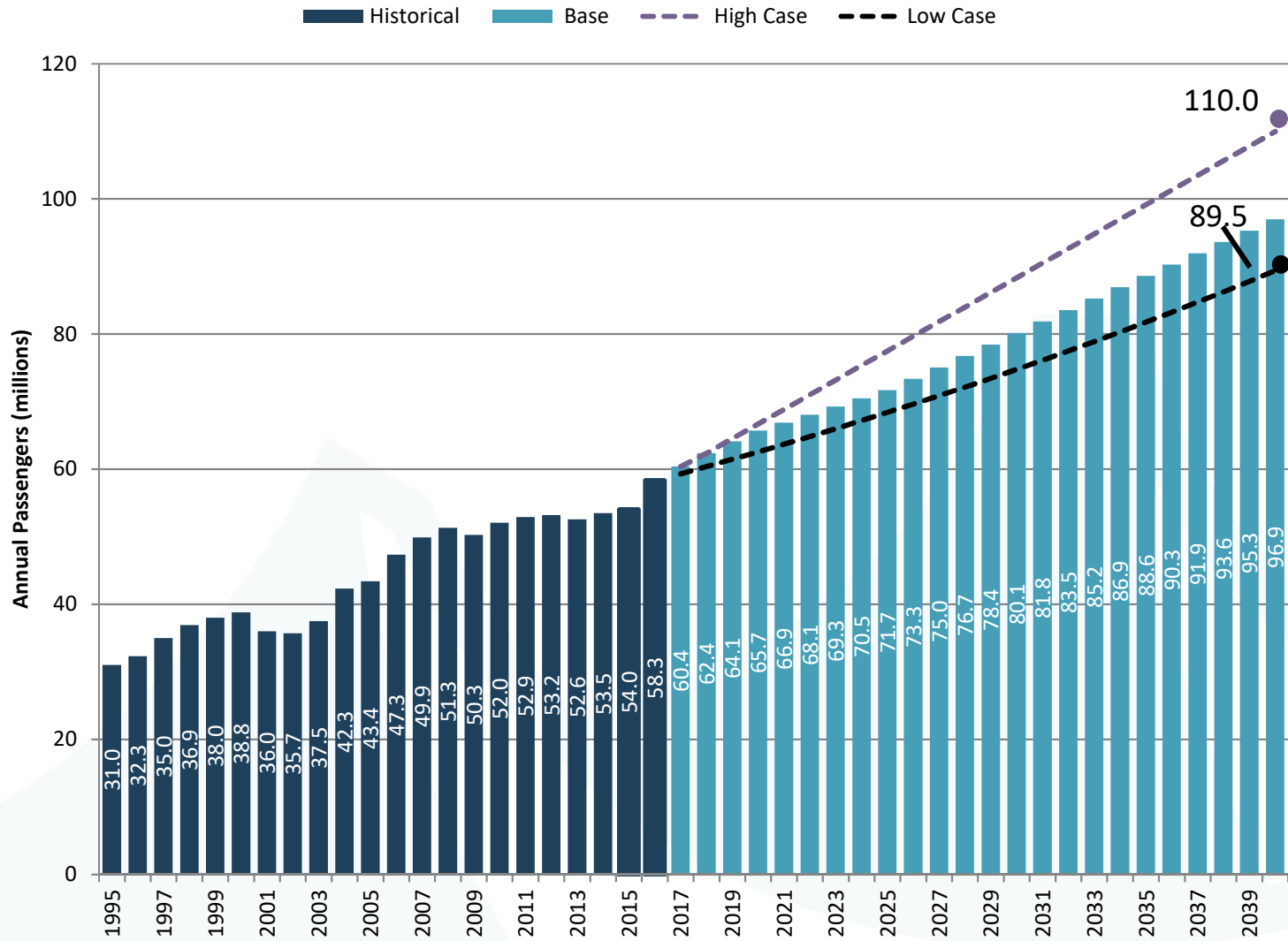

- Colorado's largest economic engine generating \$26 billion annually

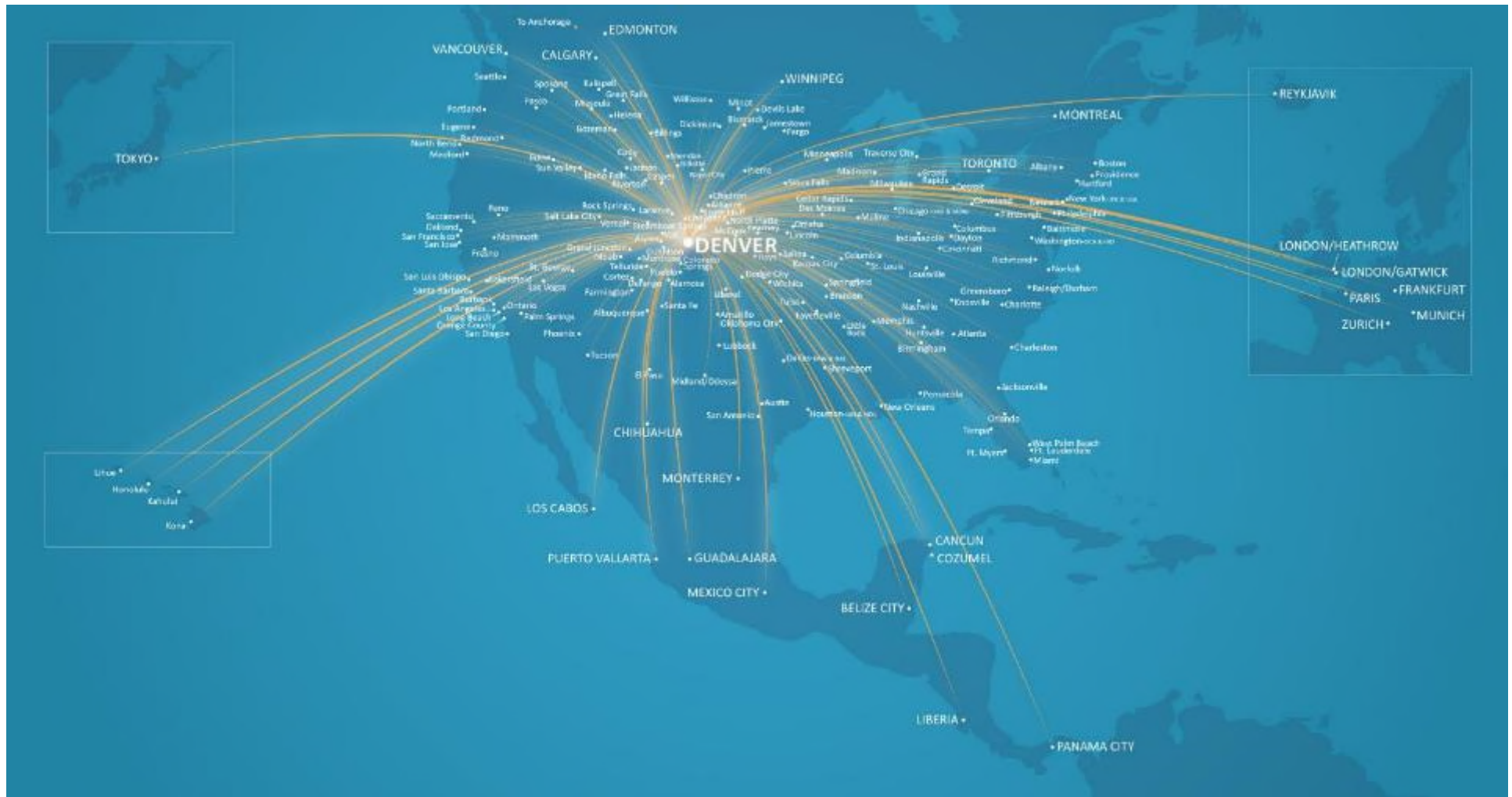

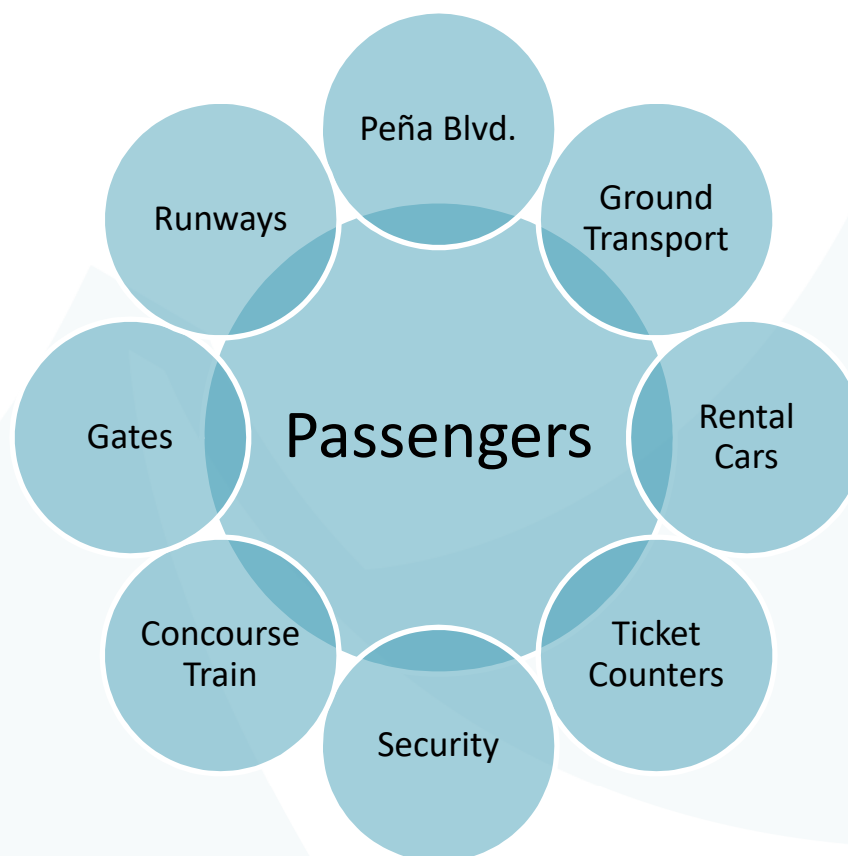

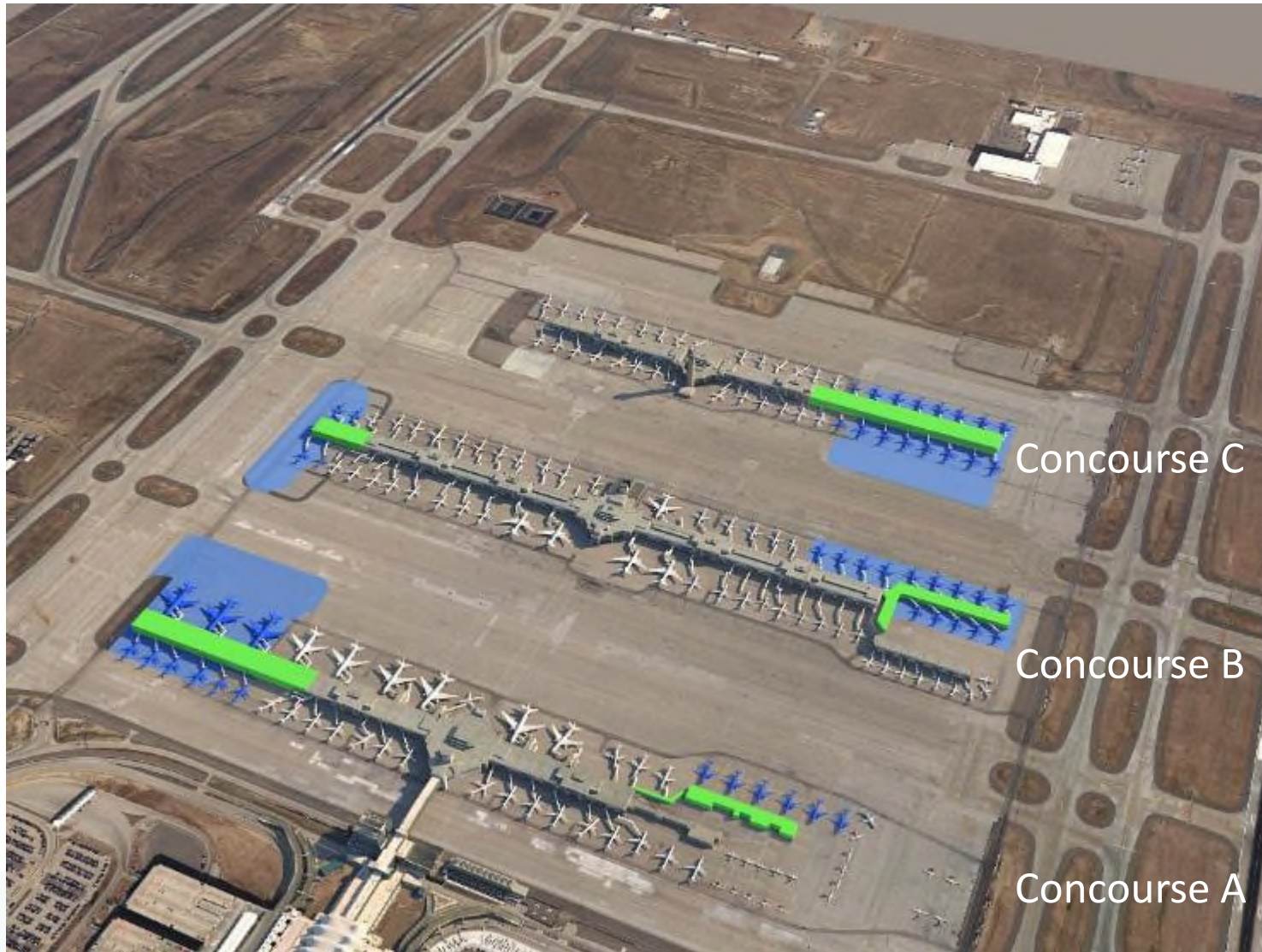

- Entire area is enclosed
- Scanning of boarding pass generates a queue assignment
- Each pair of lanes has an entry area where you validate ID and queue
- Flexibility to change lane profiles

- Body scanner for each baggage screening lane
- Diversion of alarmed passenger or bag

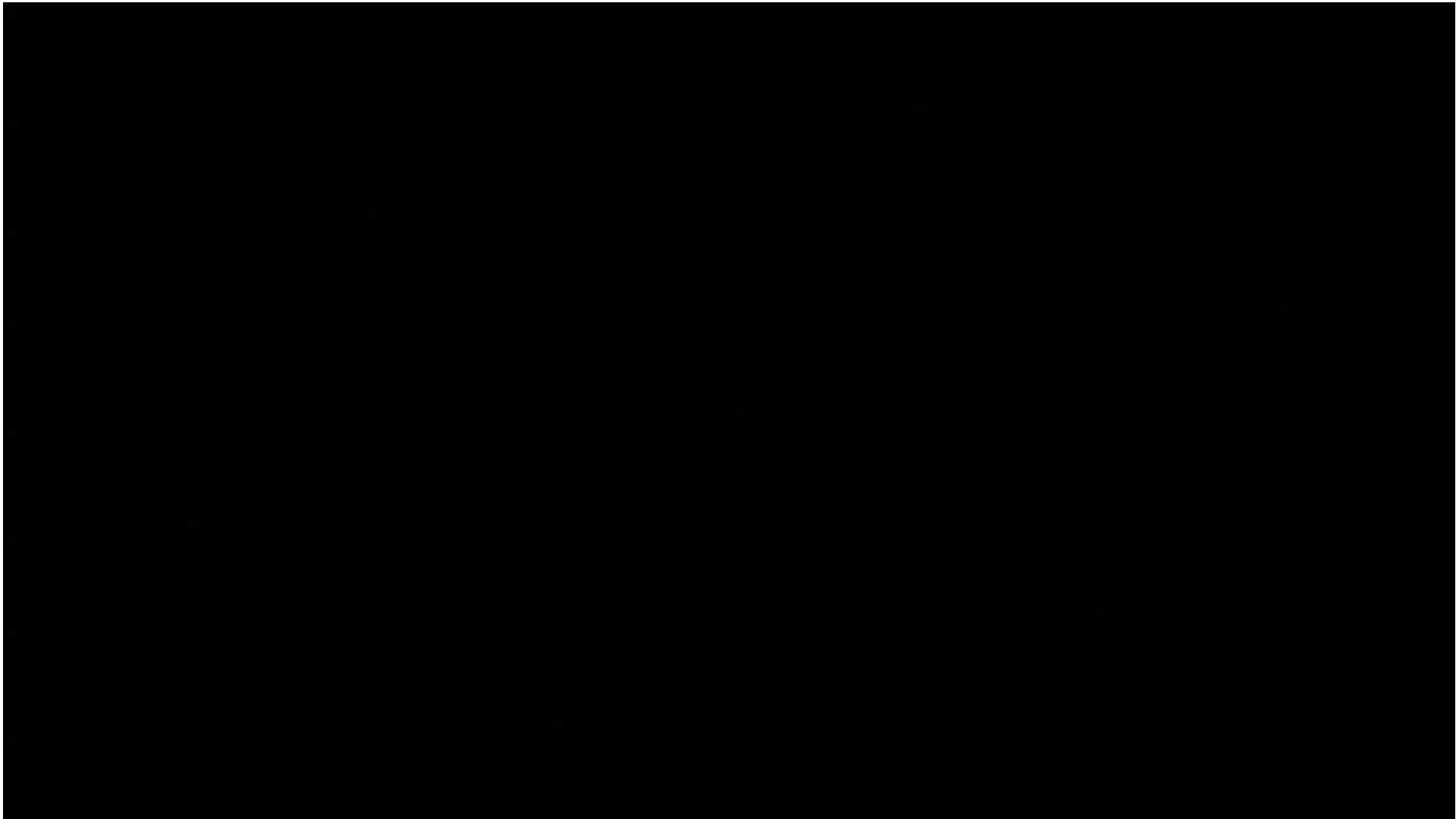

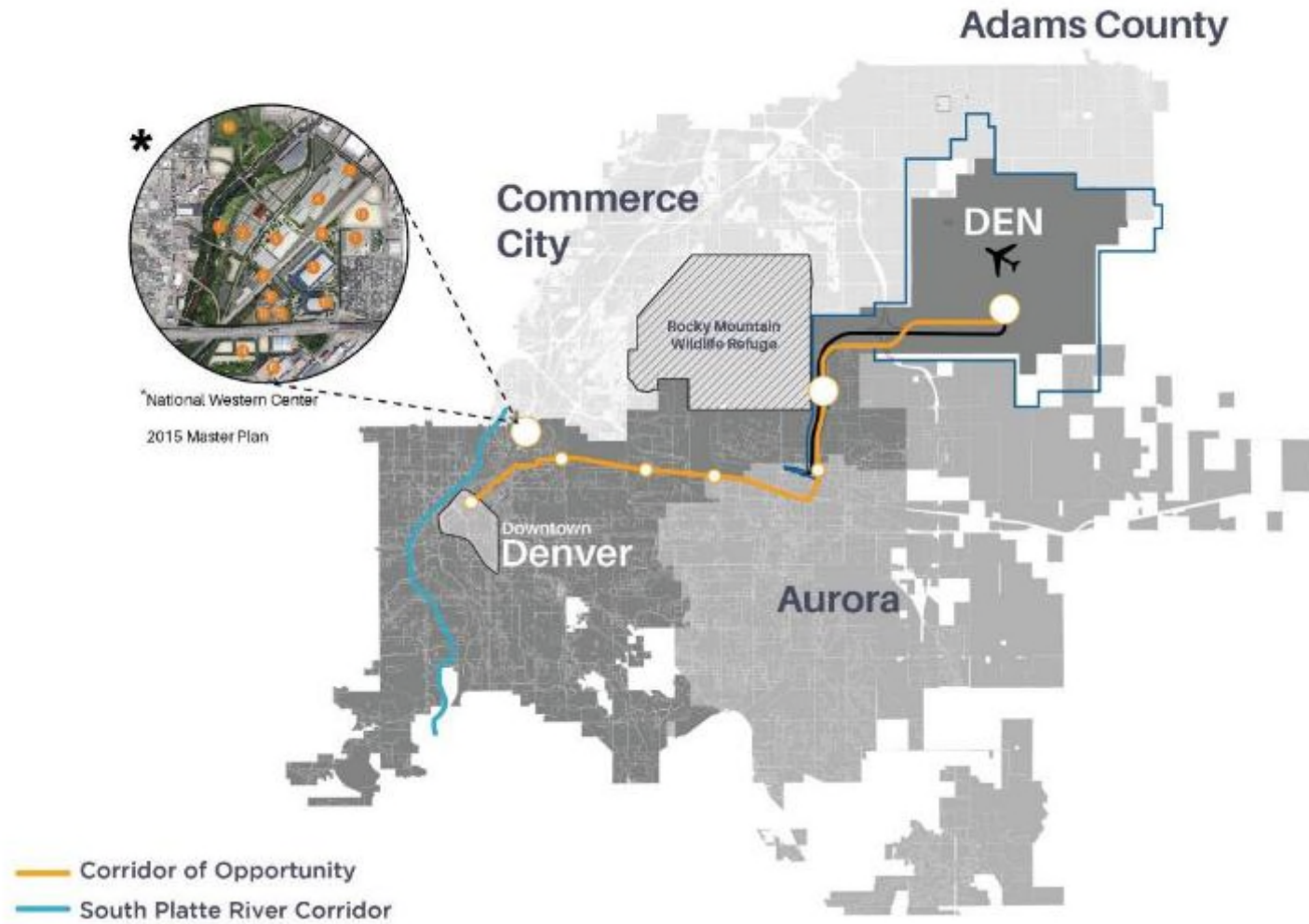

- Children's play area



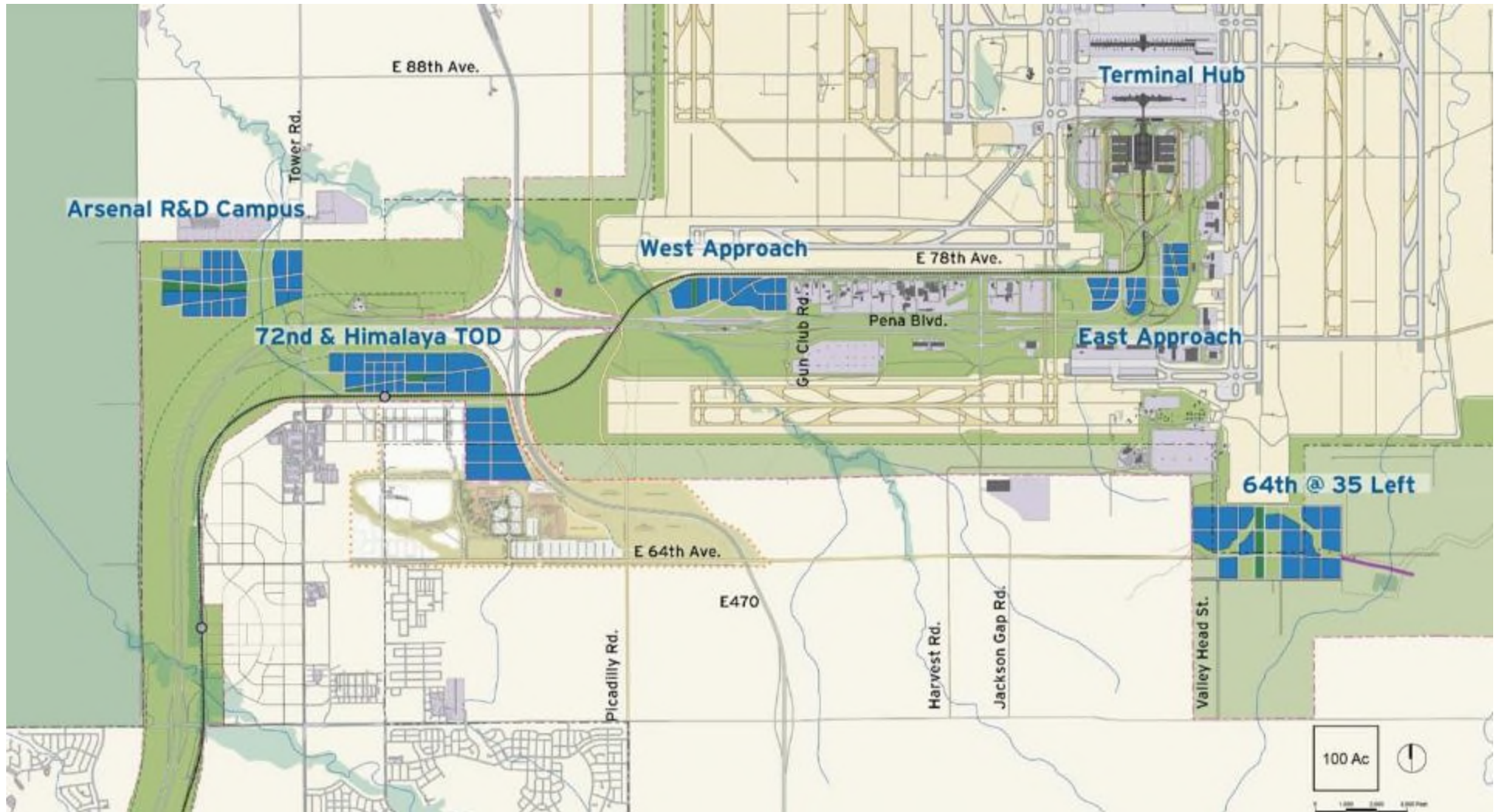
DESIGN CONCEPT







DEVELOPMENT NODES





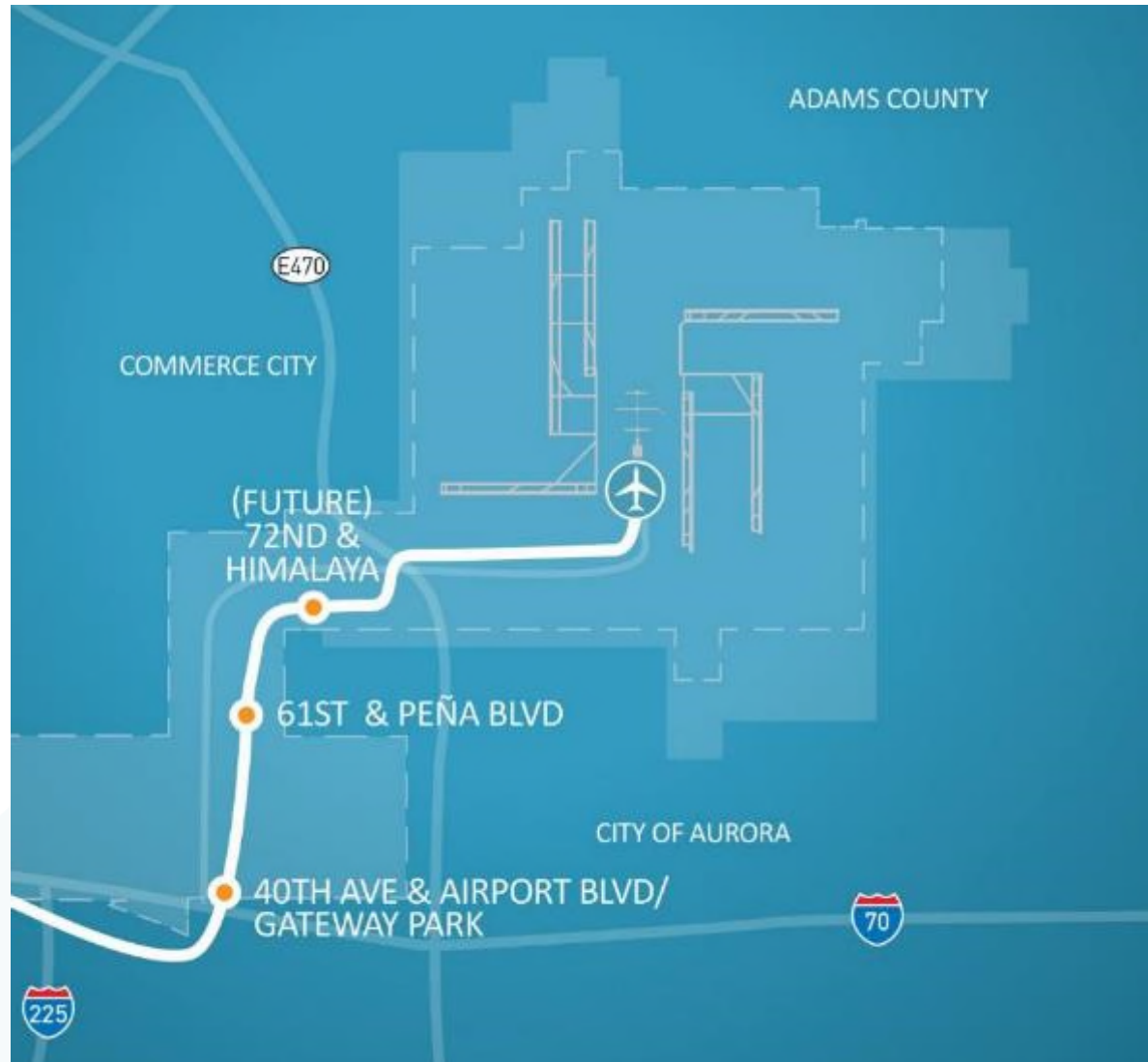
WESTIN HOTEL AND TRANSIT CENTER
