A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE USE OF AN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE TO CROSS STATE
102 HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF A MUNICIPALITY.

Bill Summary

Currently, a person may cross a state highway with an off-highway vehicle except within the jurisdiction of a municipality. The bill grants municipalities the authority to allow off-highway vehicles to cross a state highway.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-108.5,
3 **amend** (1) as follows:

4 **33-14.5-108.5. Crossing roads, highways, and railroad tracks.**

5 (1) The driver of an off-highway vehicle may directly cross a roadway,
6 including a state highway, at an at-grade crossing to continue using the
7 off-highway vehicle on the other side; except that a person shall not cross
8 a state highway within the jurisdiction of a municipality UNLESS THE
9 MUNICIPALITY AUTHORIZES A PERSON TO CROSS THE STATE HIGHWAY ON
10 AN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE.

11 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
12 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
13 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
