Bill Summary

The bill directs the department of health care policy and financing to seek federal authorization for and to implement a medicaid buy-in program for persons who are eligible for home- and community-based services under the supported living services medicaid waiver.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-6-1403, add (4)
3	as follows:
4	25.5-6-1403. Waivers and amendments. (4) THE STATE
5	DEPARTMENT SHALL SEEK FEDERAL AUTHORIZATION TO IMPLEMENT A
6	MEDICAID BUY-IN PROGRAM FOR ADULTS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE
7	HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE SUPPORTED
8	LIVING SERVICES WAIVER; THE PERSONS WITH BRAIN INJURY WAIVER, PART
9	7 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND THE SPINAL CORD INJURY WAIVER PILOT
10	PROGRAM, PART 13 OF THIS ARTICLE. THE STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL
11	PREPARE AND SUBMIT ANY REQUESTS NECESSARY FOR FEDERAL APPROVAL
12	NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2017, AND SHALL IMPLEMENT THE MEDICAID
13	BUY-IN PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (4) NOT LATER THAN
14	THREE MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING FEDERAL APPROVAL.
15	SECTION 2. Appropriation. (1) For the 2016-17 state fiscal
16	year, \$13,803 is appropriated to the department of health care policy and
17	financing for use by the executive director's office. This appropriation is
18	from the hospital provider fee cash fund created in section 25.5-4-402.3
19	(4) (a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the office may use this
20	appropriation for Medicaid management information system maintenance
21	and projects.
22	(2) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year, the general assembly
23	anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will
24	receive \$124,224 in federal funds for Medicaid management information
25	system maintenance and projects. The appropriation in subsection (1) of
26	this section is based on the assumption that the department will receive
