BILL TOPIC: ELECTION LIST MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

Summary of Legislation

This bill makes conforming amendments in state law to consistently apply terms related to the way county clerks process, record, and update voter change of address information. Currently, the Secretary of State is required to perform monthly national change of address database searches to determine if a voter has moved. This bill makes changes to the process that must be followed by the clerks to confirm a voter address if the monthly search determines that a voter may have moved.

Local Government Impact

This bill is expected to minimally impact county clerks. County clerks may have minimal an increase in workload to update voter records. In addition, to the extent that more correspondence is mailed to the voters, county clerks may incur additional costs for printing and postage.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
