**Summary of Legislation**

This bill extends the deadline by which reports on parole outcomes made by the State Board of Parole and the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ) in the Department of Public Safety are required from November 1 to March 31.

**State Expenditures**

This bill shifts workload in FY 2016-17, thereby allowing additional time for the State Board of Parole and the DCJ to complete their reports. This impact is minimal and does not require a change in appropriations for either agency.

**Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 21, 2016, and takes effect August 10, 2016, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
