BILL TOPIC: MARIJUANA HEALTH EFFECTS DATA REGIONAL LEVEL

Summary of Legislation

The bill modifies current reporting requirements for the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to allow data on changes in marijuana use patterns to be presented at a county or regional level as determined by the CDPHE. It is currently limited to the county level.

Assessment

The bill allows the CDPHE to aggregate data in a biennial report by region if it so chooses, rather than by county, to protect confidentiality. It does not affect the expenditures or workload of CDPHE or any state agency so is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 23, 2016, and takes effect August 10, 2016, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
