**BILL TOPIC:** RIGHT TO HUNT WILDLIFE

**Summary of Legislation**

This bill modifies the legislative declaration in Colorado wildlife law to clarify that Coloradans will always have the right to hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife and establishes that these are the primary methods of controlling and managing wildlife.

**Assessment**

Because a legislative declaration does not have the force of law, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state agency.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect August 10, 2016, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 11, 2016, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
