HB16-1404 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 3, line 4, strike "OFFICE." and substitut "DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE.".

- (I) ESTABLISH A REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR SMALL FANTASY CONTEST OPERATORS; AND
- (II) NOT INITIATE AN INVESTIGATION OF A POTENTIAL VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE BY A SMALL FANTASY CONTEST OPERATOR EXCEPT UPON THE FILING OF A COMPLAINT WITH THE DIRECTOR THAT THE DIRECTOR REASONABLY BELIEVES WARRANTS INVESTIGATION.

IF A LICENSEE 32 FAILS TO RENEW THE LICENSE PURSUANT TO THE SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED 33 BY THE DIRECTOR, THE LICENSE EXPIRES AND THE ENTITY SHALL NOT 34 PRACTICE UNDER THIS ARTICLE UNTIL THE REINSTATEMENT FEES ARE PAID 35 AND THE DIRECTOR REINSTATES THE LICENSE. A PERSON THAT CONTINUES 36 TO PRACTICE ONCE A LICENSE HAS EXPIRED IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES 37 PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE AND SECTION 24-34-102 (8), C.R.S."
