A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE HOME CARE ALLOWANCE GRANT PROGRAM.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill modifies the repeal date of the home care allowance grant program (program). The program will repeal when the revisor of statutes receives notice that there is a consumer-directed service delivery option available for homemaker, personal care, and medical support services for individuals who are receiving home-based and community-based services pursuant to the supported living services waiver.

The bill requires the executive director of the department of human services and the executive director of the department of health care policy

and financing to notify the revisor of statutes when the triggering event occurs.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 26-2-122.4, **amend**
3 (4)(b) as follows:

4 **26-2-122.4. Home care allowance grant program - rules -**
5 **report - repeal.** (4) (b) This section is repealed ~~effective July 1, 2017,~~
6 ~~unless extended by the general assembly~~ WHEN THERE IS A
7 CONSUMER-DIRECTED SERVICE DELIVERY OPTION AVAILABLE FOR
8 HOMEMAKER, PERSONAL CARE, AND MEDICAL SUPPORT SERVICES FOR
9 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE RECEIVING HOME-BASED AND COMMUNITY-BASED
10 SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE SUPPORTED LIVING SERVICES WAIVER. THE
11 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT AND THE EXECUTIVE
12 DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE POLICY AND FINANCING
13 SHALL JOINTLY NOTIFY THE REVISOR OF STATUTES IN WRITING WHEN THE
14 CONDITION SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4)(b) HAS OCCURRED BY
15 E-MAILING THE NOTICE TO REVISOROFSTATUTES.GA@STATE.CO.US. THIS
16 SECTION IS REPEALED UPON THE DATE IDENTIFIED IN THE NOTICE THAT THE
17 CONDITION SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4)(b) OCCURRED OR UPON THE
18 DATE OF THE NOTICE TO THE REVISOR OF STATUTES IF THE NOTICE DOES
19 NOT SPECIFY A DIFFERENT DATE.

20 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
21 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
