A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE USE OF INDUSTRIAL HEMP IN PRODUCTS DESIGNED

FOR CONSUMPTION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Currently, it is illegal to sell animal feed that is deemed adulterated. The bill clarifies that the use of industrial hemp does not adulterate feed.
