Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendations of the sunset review and report on the school safety resource center advisory board (board) by eliminating the repeal date of the board and extending the board indefinitely.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1804, **repeal**
3 (6) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-1804. School safety resource center advisory board -**
5 **created.** (6) (a) ~~This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.~~

6 (b) ~~Prior to said repeal, the advisory board appointed pursuant to~~
7 ~~this section shall be reviewed as provided in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.~~

8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**
9 (4)(a)(VIII) as follows:

11 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (4) (a) The following statutory
12 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July

16 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
