A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF THE SCHOOL SAFETY RESOURCE CENTER ADVISORY BOARD.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendations of the sunset review and report on the school safety resource center advisory board (board) by eliminating the repeal date of the board and extending the board indefinitely.
