SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 17-044
CONCERNING PARTICIPATION IN A PLANNING CONVENTION FOR AN
ARTICLE V CONVENTION FOR PROPOSING A BALANCED BUDGET
AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.
WHEREAS, The national debt and mounting deficits are an
existential threat to the solvency, security, and prosperity of the United
States; and
WHEREAS, Congress has increased the total national debt every
year since 1957; and
WHEREAS, Under Article V of the United States Constitution,
Congress shall call a convention of the states for proposing amendments
to the constitution on the application of the legislatures of two-thirds of
the states; and

1	WHEREAS, In 1978, the Colorado General Assembly
2	memorialized Congress to call a constitutional convention for the specific
3	and exclusive purpose of proposing an amendment to the federal
4	constitution prohibiting deficit spending except under conditions
5	specified in the amendment; and

7	resolutions applying for a convention to propose a balanced budget
8	amendment pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution,
9	thereby rendering it appropriate to select and instruct commissioners to
