**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$5,945,392 from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund to the Department of Local Affairs for FY 2017-18. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.3 FTE.
