The Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note, dated February 13, 2017 (Fiscal Note), identifies a savings of \$642,786 General Fund associated with the bill. However, because the state funding for the Colorado Student Assessment Program is from the State Education Fund, the bill's impact is restricted to the State Education Fund. Thus, this analysis assumes that the bill allows for a reduction of \$642,786 cash funds from the State Education Fund (below the FY 2017-18 Long Bill appropriation which will be based on current law).
