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**BILL TOPIC:** RELOCATE TITLE 12 WHOLESALE SALES REPRESENTATIVES

### **Summary of Legislation**

This bill relocates the statutes concerning the regulation of wholesale sales representatives from Title 12 to Title 13 of the Colorado Revised Statutes and makes minor technical changes.

### **Background**

The Committee on Legal Services is currently supervising the Office of Legislative Legal Services in a two-year project to recodify Title 12 of the C.R.S., as directed by Senate Bill 16-163. In anticipation of this recodification, House Bill 17-1006 was enacted to allow agencies to request the Secretary of State to update statutory citations in the Code of Colorado Regulations without the agency notice, comment, or hearing requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act.

### **Assessment**

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Relocating these sections of statute will not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency.

### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 25, 2017, and became effective on August 9, 2017.
