Related Budget Information

As indicated on page three of the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note, the fiscal impact for FY 2018-19 is based on a 5.65 percent salary increase for judicial officers for FY 2017-18. Neither the reengrossed or rerevised versions of the FY 2017-18 Long Bill (S.B. 17-254) includes judicial officer salary increases of this magnitude. If the final version of the Long Bill includes salary increases that are smaller than anticipated in the Fiscal Note, the projected fiscal impact of the bill in FY 2018-19 will be smaller.
