BILL TOPIC: REVISOR'S BILL

Summary of Legislation

This bill, **recommended by the Committee on Legal Services**, amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of existing statute. The bill's appendix explains the reasons for each amendment.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill only makes technical changes to existing statute and does not impact the revenues or expenditures of any agency of state or local government.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took on May 25, 2017, with the exception of:

- Section 117, which takes effect on the effective date of HB 17-1115, August 9, 2017, assuming no referendum petition is filed; and
- Section 118, which became effective on July 1, 2017, the effective date of Senate Bill 17-153.
