Status

This research note reflects the final version of the bill and became effective on April 6, 2017.

Background

Current federal law requires that all patients be notified of the results of a mammogram. The bill seeks to require that the patient's breast density be included in the required notification of the results of a mammogram.

Senate Action

Senate Health and Human Services Committee (February 16, 2017). At the hearing, representatives of Women's Imaging Center, QSUM Biopsy Disposables, University of Colorado, Colorado Radiological Society, Colorado OB/GYN Association, and three members of the public testified in support of the bill.

The committee referred the bill to the Committee of the Whole with no amendments.

Senate second reading (February 27, 2017). The Senate passed the bill on second reading with no amendments.

Senate third reading (February 28, 2017). The Senate passed the bill on third reading with no amendments.

House Action

House Public Health Care & Human Services Committee (March 21, 2017). At the hearing, representatives of the Colorado Radiological Society, the Colorado Breast Density Coalition, the

Colorado Section - American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, and one member of the public testified in support of the bill.

The committee referred the bill to the Committee of the Whole with no amendments.

House second reading (March 24, 2017). The House passed the bill on second reading with no amendments.

House third reading (March 27, 2017). The House passed the bill on third reading with no amendments.
