After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB17-1059 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 17 through 22.

2 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 9 and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-1.3-407, **amend**
4 (10)(b) as follows:
5 **18-1.3-407. Sentences - youthful offenders - legislative**
6 **declaration - powers and duties of district court - authorization for**
7 **youthful offender system - powers and duties of department of**
8 **corrections - definitions.** (10) (b) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 24-1-136
9 (11)(a)(I), the division of criminal justice shall independently monitor
10 and evaluate, or contract with a public or private entity to independently
11 monitor and evaluate, the youthful offender system. On or before
12 November 1, 2002, and on or before November 1 every two years
13 thereafter, the division of criminal justice shall report its findings, or the
14 findings of the contract entity, to the judiciary committees of the senate
15 and the house of representatives. The department of corrections shall
16 cooperate in providing the necessary data to the division of criminal
17 justice or an entity designated by the division of criminal justice to
18 complete the evaluation required in this section."

19 Page 4, strike lines 8 through 16 and substitute "NOTWITHSTANDING
20 SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), the division of the Colorado bureau of
21 investigation is authorized to accept, receive, and expend proceeds

1 allocated to the division after sale of forfeited property pursuant to part
2 3 or 5 of article 13 of title 16 ~~C.R.S.~~, or article 17 of title 18, ~~C.R.S.~~, and
3 such funds shall be in addition to the ~~moneys~~ MONEY appropriated to the
4 division by the general assembly. The executive director shall submit an
5 annual report to the joint budget committee at the time the annual budget
6 request is submitted providing information on the amounts received under
7 this section, if any, and the uses made thereof."

8 Page 4, strike lines 17 through 27.

9 Page 5, strike lines 1 and 2 and substitute:

10 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-424, amend
11 (3.5)(f) introductory portion as follows:

12 **24-33.5-424. National instant criminal background check**
13 **system - state point of contact - fee - grounds for denial of firearm**
14 **transfer - appeal - rule-making - unlawful acts - instant criminal**
15 **background check cash fund - creation.** (3.5) (f) NOTWITHSTANDING
16 SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), on January 15, 2014, and on January 15 of
17 each calendar year thereafter, the bureau shall report to the joint budget
18 committee concerning:"

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
