"SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-22-113, add (1)(a.5) as follows:

16-22-113. Petition for removal from registry. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3) of this section, any person required to register pursuant to section 16-22-103 or whose information is required to be posted on the internet pursuant to section 16-22-111 may file a petition with the court that issued the order of judgment for the conviction that requires the person to register for an order to discontinue the requirement for such registration or internet posting, or both, as follows:

(a.5) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (1)(d), (1)(e), AND (1)(f) OF THIS SECTION, IF THE OFFENSE THAT REQUIRED THE PERSON TO REGISTER CONSTITUTED HUMAN TRAFFICKING FOR SEXUAL SERVITUDE PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-3-504 (1)(a), UPON COMPLETION OF THE PERSON'S SENTENCE AND HIS OR HER DISCHARGE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, IF HE OR SHE WAS SENTENCED TO INCARCERATION, OR DISCHARGE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, IF HE OR SHE WAS COMMITTED TO SUCH DEPARTMENT, OR FINAL RELEASE FROM THE JURISDICTION OF THE COURT FOR THE OFFENSE, IF THE PERSON HAS NOT SUBSEQUENTLY BEEN CONVICTED OF UNLAWFUL SEXUAL BEHAVIOR OR OF ANY OTHER OFFENSE, THE UNDERLYING FACTUAL BASIS OF WHICH INVOLVED UNLAWFUL SEXUAL BEHAVIOR, THE PERSON MAY FILE A PETITION WITH THE COURT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER INFORMATION OBTAINED BY THE COURT DURING THE HEARING OF THE PETITION, A COURT SHALL NOT ISSUE AN ORDER DISCONTINUING THE PETITIONER'S DUTY TO REGISTER UNLESS THE PETITIONER HAS AT LEAST ESTABLISHED BY A PREPONDERANCE OF THE EVIDENCE THAT AT THE TIME HE OR SHE COMMITTED THE OFFENSE OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING FOR SEXUAL SERVITUDE, HE OR SHE HAD BEEN TRAFFICKED BY ANOTHER PERSON, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 18-3-503 OR 18-3-504, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMMITTING THE OFFENSE. FAILURE TO MAKE THE REQUIRED SHOWING PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1)(a.5)
