Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly. Page 6, after line 16 insert: "(6) The STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSIDER NEW TECHNOLOGIES AND BUSINESS PRACTICES FOR MEDICAL MANAGEMENT REFORM THAT WOULD REDUCE MEDICAL COSTS DUE TO MISUSE, OVERUSE, WASTE, FRAUD, AND ABUSE.
