## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

<u>SB17-259</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, strike line 14.
- Page 2, line 15, strike "TWENTY-SEVEN" and substitute "NINE HUNDRED
  FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE".
- 4 Page 2, after line 17 insert:

5 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-31-313, amend
6 (10)(a) as follows:

7 23-31-313. Healthy forests - vibrant communities - funds 8 created - repeal. (10) Healthy forests and vibrant communities fund. 9 (a) (I) There is hereby created in the state treasury the healthy forests and 10 vibrant communities fund. The fund shall consist CONSISTS of all moneys 11 MONEY that may be appropriated thereto by the general assembly, all 12 private and public moneys MONEY received through gifts, grants, 13 reimbursements, or donations that are transmitted to the state treasurer 14 and credited to the fund, and all moneys MONEY transferred to the fund 15 pursuant to section  $39-29-109.3(2)(n) \frac{C.R.S.}{AND SUBSECTION(10)(a)(II)}$ 16 OF THIS SECTION. All interest earned from the investment of moneys 17 MONEY in the fund shall be IS credited to the fund. The moneys MONEY in 18 the fund are IS hereby continuously appropriated for the purposes 19 specified in this subsection (10) and shall remain REMAINS available until 20 expended. Any moneys MONEY not expended at the end of the fiscal year 21 shall remain in the fund and shall not be transferred to or revert to the

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1 general fund.

(II) ON JULY 1, 2017, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ONE
MILLION ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE HEALTHY
FORESTS AND VIBRANT COMMUNITIES FUND.".

- 6 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 7 Page 3, after line 15 insert:

8 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1212,
9 amend (5)(a) as follows:

10 24-33.5-1212. Training for directors of fire protection districts - pilot program - advisory board - training fund - repeal. 11 12 (5) (a) (I) The division shall offer courses to directors of fire protection 13 districts in accordance with this section at no charge and shall seek gifts, 14 grants, and donations to fund the pilot program created pursuant to this 15 section. EXCEPT FOR THE MONEY TRANSFERRED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 16 SUBSECTION (5)(a)(II) OF THIS SECTION, no general fund moneys MONEY 17 shall be expended for the implementation of the program. 18 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the division shall not 19 implement the program until the division receives sufficient 20 appropriations, gifts, grants, or donations to cover the costs of 21 implementing the program. The division shall transmit gifts, grants, and 22 donations received in accordance with this subsection (5) to the state treasurer, who shall credit the moneys, along with any moneys 23 24 appropriated by the general assembly, to the wildland-urban interface 25 training fund, which fund is hereby created in the state treasury. Any 26 moneys MONEY in the fund in excess of those needed for the training of 27 directors of fire protection districts shall be used for the purpose of 28 providing firefighters with basic wildland firefighting and wildland-urban 29 interface firefighting training through existing wildland fire training 30 programs. All interest derived from the deposit and investment of moneys 31 MONEY in the fund shall be IS credited to the fund. Moneys MONEY not 32 expended at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the fund and shall not 33 be transferred or revert to the general fund.

34 (II) ON JULY 1, 2017, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER
35 FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS FROM THE
36 GENERAL FUND TO THE WILDLAND-URBAN INTERFACE TRAINING FUND.

37 SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1227,
38 amend (1)(a) as follows:

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24-33.5-1227. Wildfire preparedness fund - creation - gifts, 1 2 grants, and donations authorized - wildfire preparedness plan -3 report. (1) (a) (I) There is hereby created in the state treasury the 4 wildfire preparedness fund. The fund consists of all moneys MONEY that may be appropriated thereto by the general assembly, all private and 5 6 public moneys MONEY received through gifts, grants, reimbursements, or donations that are transmitted to the state treasurer and credited to the 7 8 fund, all moneys MONEY transferred to the fund pursuant to section 9 34-63-102 (5.4)(b)(II), C.R.S., all moneys MONEY transferred to the fund 10 from the healthy forests and vibrant communities fund created in section 11 23-31-313 (10), C.R.S., and moneys MONEY transferred pursuant to section 39-29-109.3 (2)(n)(I)(C), C.R.S. AND MONEY TRANSFERRED 12 13 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a)(II) OF THIS SECTION. All interest earned 14 from the investment of moneys MONEY in the fund shall be credited to the 15 fund. The moneys MONEY in the fund are IS hereby continuously appropriated for the purposes indicated in this section. Any moneys 16 MONEY not expended at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund 17 18 and shall not be transferred to or revert to the general fund.

(II) ON JULY 1, 2017, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER
EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS FROM THE
GENERAL FUND TO THE WILDFIRE PREPAREDNESS FUND.".
