HOUSE BILL 18-1236

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) McLachlan and Becker J., Arndt, Exum, Hansen, Lee, Roberts, Rosenthal, Valdez, Young, Duran, Ginal, Winter; also SENATOR(S) Baumgardner, Coram, Crowder, Guzman.

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COLORADO FOOD SYSTEMS ADVISORY COUNCIL, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES' SUNSET REPORT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (7)(a)(I); and **add** (14)(a)(X) as follows:

2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative declaration - definition - repeal. (7) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on September 1, 2018:

(I) ~~The Colorado food systems advisory council created in section 24-37.3-102, C.R.S.;~~

(14) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2023:

(X) THE COLORADO FOOD SYSTEMS ADVISORY COUNCIL CREATED IN SECTION 24-37.3-102.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 24-37.3-107 as follows:

24-37.3-107. Repeal of article. This article **37.3** is repealed, effective September 1, ~~2018~~ **2023**. Prior to such repeal, the food systems advisory council shall be reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203. ~~C.R.S.~~

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2018

and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
