## **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$530,448 General Fund to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.5 FTE.

# **Points to Consider**

## General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its budget package \$8,000,000 General Fund set-aside for FY 2018-19 for Educator Preparation Programs in the Department of Education. This bill includes an appropriation to the Department of Higher Education, rather than the Department of Education; however, it provides funding for an educator preparation program.
