#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$87,443 cash funds from the Judgment Debtor Disclosure Fund to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.1 FTE. The amendment also adds an appropriation of \$30,800 reappropriated funds to the Governor's Office of Information Technology from the amount appropriated to the Department of Labor and
