Bill Topic: UPDATE PUBLISHING REQUIREMENT DOR TAXES PAID TABLE

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill removes a statutory reference to the mailing of the income tax booklet by the Department of Revenue (DOR) and instead requires that the disclosure of average taxes paid be made via the DOR's website and its individual income tax filing software. The bill aligns state statute with current practice.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes a statutory reference to the mailing of the income tax booklet by the Department of Revenue (DOR) and instead requires that the disclosure of average taxes paid be made via the DOR's website and its individual income tax filing software.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact because it aligns state statute with current practice, and therefore, has no effect on state or local government revenue, expenditures, or workload.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 8, 2018, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 9, 2018, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
