Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriations clause that appropriates:

- \$125,356 cash funds to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE.
- \$19,917 reappropriated funds to the Department of Personnel from the amount appropriated to the Department of Regulatory Agencies. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Personnel will require an additional 0.2 FTE.
- \$64,575 reappropriated funds to the Department of Law from the amount appropriated to the

Department of Regulatory Agencies. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Law will require an additional 0.3 FTE.
