**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$2,115 General Fund to the State Historical Society within the Department of Higher Education for FY 2018-19.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$40.8 million General Fund unallocated. Thus, the General Assembly could appropriate up to \$38.3 million General Fund to fund 2018 legislation and maintain a 6.5 percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$2,115 for FY 2018-19,

reducing the excess General Fund reserve by \$2,253.
