Summary of **Fiscal Impact:** Sunset bill. No fiscal impact. House Bill 18-1239 repeals the Environmental Management System Permit Program as scheduled on July 1, 2018. The program

does not receive funding or staffing so the repeal has no fiscal impact.

Fiscal Note Status:

Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals the Environmental Management System Permit Program in the Department of Public Health and Environment as scheduled on July 1, 2018.

Background

An environmental management system is a set of processes and practices, including review and evaluation, that enables an organization to improve its operating efficiency while reducing its environmental impacts. Three facilities participated in the program's pilot in 2007, but the program has been inactive since then.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The program does not receive funding or staffing so the repeal has no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 3, 2018.
