Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Bill Sponsor amendment **J.001** (attached) adds a provision appropriating a total of \$1,642,843 to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2018-19, including \$1,082,522 General Fund and \$560,321 reappropriated funds from indirect cost recoveries. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Civil Rights Division will require an additional 27.2 FTE, and the Department will receive \$496,489 federal funds to implement the act. This appropriation is consistent with the Department's FY 2018-19 budget request for the Civil Rights Division.

Related Budget Information

The general appropriations bill for FY 2018-19 (the FY 2018-19 Long Bill) has not yet been introduced. If sponsor amendment J.001 is adopted, the same funding would not be needed in the FY 2018-19 Long Bill.
