The bill includes an appropriations clause that provides \$1,570,395 General Fund to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing in FY 2018-19, and assumes federal funds revenue of \$1,070,395 and 0.9 FTE, for the operation of the All-Payer Health Claims Database.

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2018-19 budget package a \$1,570,395 General Fund appropriation for FY 2018-19 for implementation of this bill.
