Points to Consider

Future Budget Processes

This bill does not require additional appropriations for FY 2018-19. However, to implement this legislation, the Department of Natural Resources may submit a budget request to adjust FY 2018-19 appropriations mid-year, or may request additional appropriations for FY 2019-20. The fiscal impact of the bill would be quantified at that time. The Department cannot estimate at this time whether

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there will be additional costs to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission to implement the new rules required by this legislation.
