**Bill Topic:** UPDATE REFERENCES COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill updates outdated references in statute to "county departments of social services" to "county departments of human or social services." It has no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

### Summary of Legislation

This bill updates references in statute to county "departments of social services" to county "departments of human or social services." This change reflects that county departments use both social services and human services to describe their local agencies responsible for public assistance, child welfare, and other services.

### Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Changing the name of the local agencies in statute does not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state or local government.

### Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 8, 2018, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 9, 2018, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
