Bill Topic: CORRECTION TO HB 17-1367 CHANGE "AND" TO "OR"

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill corrects an error from House Bill 17-1367 that required marijuana testing labs to meet two standards.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

House Bill 17-1367 required that beginning January 1, 2018, testing of medical and retail marijuana and marijuana-infused products be conducted by an analytical laboratory certified by the Marijuana Enforcement Division (MED) in the Department of Revenue and accredited pursuant to the International Organization for Standardization/International Electrotechnical Commission (international) standard. This bill clarifies that a laboratory need only be certified by the MED or accredited pursuant to the international standard beginning January 1, 2018.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill corrects an error in statute that became effective January 1, 2018, and has not yet been implemented. It will not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 15, 2018.
