AN ACT

CONCERNING AN EXPANSION OF THE ABILITY TO LEAVE A MOTOR VEHICLE UNATTENDED IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-4-1206, **amend** (3) as follows:

42-4-1206. Unattended motor vehicle - definitions. (3) The use or operation of a remote starter system ~~and~~ OR adequate security measures is sufficient to comply with subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
