After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB18-1313 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 7, strike "(a)".
- 2 Page 2, strike lines 18 through 26 and substitute "individual patients.
- 3 "Pharmaceutical care" does not include prescriptive authority; except that
- 4 a pharmacist may prescribe only over-the-counter medications to a
- 5 recipient under the "Colorado Medical Assistance Act" as authorized
- 6 pursuant to section 25.5-5-322 ~~C.R.S.~~ OR PURSUANT TO A
- 7 COLLABORATIVE PHARMACY PRACTICE AGREEMENT AS DEFINED IN
- 8 SECTION 12-42.5-601 (1)(b).".
- 9 Page 3, strike lines 7 through 9 and substitute:

10 **"SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
11 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
12 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
13 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
14 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
15 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
16 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
17 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
18 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
19 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.".

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
