Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB18-027 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 37, after line 10 insert:

2 **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2017-18 state fiscal
3 year, \$233,702 is appropriated to the department of public safety for use
4 by the biometric identification and records unit, which amount is based
5 on an assumption that the unit will require an additional 0.5 FTE. This
6 appropriation is from the Colorado bureau of investigation identification
7 unit fund created in section 24-33.5-426, C.R.S. To implement this act,
8 the unit may use this appropriation for criminal history record checks.

9 (2) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$114,000 is appropriated to
10 the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the
11 professions and occupations cash fund created in section 24-34-105
12 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
13 appropriation as follows:

14 (a) \$4,000 for use by the division of professions and occupations
15 for operating expenses; and

16 (b) \$110,000 for the purchase of information technology services.

17 (3) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$110,000 is appropriated to
18 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
19 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
20 department of regulatory agencies under subsection (2)(b) of this section.
21 To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
22 information technology services for the department of regulatory
23 agencies.

1 **SECTION 8. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
2 year, \$336,009 is appropriated to the department of public safety for use
3 by the biometric identification and records unit, which amount is based
4 on an assumption that the unit will require an additional 2.0 FTE. This
5 appropriation is from the Colorado bureau of investigation identification
6 unit fund created in section 24-33.5-426, C.R.S. To implement this act,
7 the unit may use this appropriation for criminal history record checks.

8 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$134,746 is appropriated to
9 the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the
10 professions and occupations cash fund created in section 24-34-105
11 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
12 appropriation as follows:

13 (a) \$38,403 for use by the division of professions and occupations
14 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the
15 division will require an additional 0.6 FTE;

16 (b) \$2,570 for use by the division of professions and occupations
17 for operating expenses; and

18 (c) \$93,773 for the purchase of legal services.

19 (3) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$93,773 is appropriated to
20 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
21 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection
22 (2)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department
23 of law will require an additional 0.5 FTE. To implement this act, the
24 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for
25 the department of regulatory agencies."

26 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

27 Page 1, line 102, strike "COMPACT." and substitute "COMPACT, AND, IN
28 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
