REPEAL COPHE HEALTH FACILITY LIFE SAFETY STATUTES **Bill Topic:**

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill removes obsolete statutory language related to the **Fiscal Impact:**

Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's role in fire safety and the life safety code in health facilities. House Bill 12-1268 transferred these duties to the Department of Public Safety. The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

No appropriation is required. **Appropriation**

Summary:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory **Fiscal Note** Status: **Revision Committee**

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes obsolete statutory language that requires Board of Health to adopt rules relating to fire safety of health facilities and removes language that allows the Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to establish a life safety code for health facilities and assess penalties for noncompliance. HB 12-1268 transferred these duties to the Division of Fire Safety in the Department of Public Safety.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The Board of Health and CDPHE no longer perform the responsibilities that are removed by the bill. Therefore, it will not impact the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state or local government agency.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
