Bill Topic: DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME EXEMPTION

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill exempts the state from observing daylight savings and will have no effect on state and local revenue or expenditures.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill exempts the state from observing daylight saving time, making Mountain Standard Time the standard time year round.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Exempting the state from observing daylight saving time will have no impact to the revenue, expenditures, or workload to any state or local government and therefore, is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Because state applications and servers are expected to update without any intervention, the fiscal note assumes that no IT modifications are necessary by the Office of Information Technology.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
