Bill Topic: LANDOWNER CONSENT LISTING NATIONAL REGISTER

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill requires the consent of the property owner before the property may be listed on the national register of historical places.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

This bill requires an applicant seeking to place a property on the national register of historic places, to obtain the consent of the property owner before the state historical society can take any action to approve the request.

Background

In Colorado, the state historical society in the Department of Higher Education assists property owners in being placed on the national register of historic places. The national register of historic places is a list of historically significant buildings, districts, sites, structures, and objects worthy of preservation.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill is a requirement primarily on private individuals and is not expected to change workload or revenue for any agency of the state or local government. For these reasons, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 12, 2019, and took effect August 2, 2019.
