Bill Topic: CDPHE EMERGENCY EPIDEMIC PREPAREDNESS

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill removes obsolete language from statute concerning emerging epidemic preparedness. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals an obsolete statutory provision requiring the State Board of Health to adopt rules and establish standards requiring area trauma advisory councils and managed care organizations to prepare for an emergency epidemic.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill removes a portion of statute that is obsolete. It will not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
