No later than July 1, 2020, the department of human services (department), with assistance from other departments and organizations, shall create and maintain a website that provides internet links to relevant information and resources available to individuals seeking behavioral health care services. The website must include information about the

HOUSE Amended 2nd Reading June 9, 2020 Colorado SEE ME campaign and the national suicide prevention hotline, demographic-specific information about behavioral health care providers available in each geographic region, internet links to each behavioral health care provider's website, and internet links to skilled nursing facilities available in each geographic region.

No later than April 1, 2021, the department shall issue a request for proposal to contract with an organization to develop and distribute community- and demographic-specific targeted messaging related to the website. The messaging must be distributed no later than January 1, 2022.

The bill allows a health care professional who is required to complete continuing competency requirements to take a course in mental health education to satisfy the continuing competency requirements.

13 (3) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2021, THE DEPARTMENT, IN 14 COLLABORATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL DEVISE A PROCESS AND 15 DEVELOP STANDARDIZED PROTOCOLS SO THAT ANY COMMUNICATION 16 RELATED TO MENTAL HEALTH OR SUBSTANCE USE RECEIVED BY 17 SAFE2TELL, INCLUDING ANY COMMUNICATION RELATED TO ANOTHER 18 PERSON, MAY BE TRANSFERRED, AS APPROPRIATE, TO THE STATEWIDE 19 BEHAVIORAL CRISIS RESPONSE SYSTEM CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 20 27-60-103.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
