Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$13,347 cash funds from the Division of Insurance Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies, and is based on the assumption that the Department will require 0.2 FTE.

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Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

Begining in FY 20-21, the bill diverts an estimated \$13,347 General Fund as a result of increased costs in the Division of Insurance. Tax revenues from premuims are credited to the General Fund when not used to cover costs associated with operating the Division,
