The bill includes an appropriation clause that adds \$500,000 to the Department of Human Services for FY 2019-20 and specifies that this amount come from the CARES Act subfund in the General Fund.

The bill appropriates CARES Act funds through December 30, 2020. If programs and services initiated by CARES Act funds continue beyond December 30, 2020, General Fund would be required to cover the ongoing costs.
