HOSPITAL PATIENT VISITATION RIGHTS DURING COVID-19 Bill Topic:

Summary of Legislation

The bill is a statutory declaration which encourages hospitals to establish safety protocols enabling patient visitation as knowledge about the COVID-19 pandemic advances.

As statutory declarations bear no legal weight, the bill does not affect the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state or local agency, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on June 29, 2020.
