# **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, the Bureau of Animal Protection in the Department of Agriculture (CDA) assists local law enforcement in animal cruelty and neglect cases. The bill allows Bureau of Animal Protection agents to conduct investigations.

# State Expenditures

The bill will increase workload for the Bureau of Animal Protection in the Department of Agriculture to conduct investigations. This workload increase can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

### Local Government

To the extent that additional duties and powers allow Bureau of Animal Protection agents to provide added support to local law enforcement, the bill may reduce workload for local law enforcement. These impacts will vary and have not been estimated.

### Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 29, 2020, and takes effect September 14, 2020, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
