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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101      **CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF MEMBERS OF BOARDS OF HEALTH,**  
102                      **AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REGULATING THE MEMBERS**  
103                      **OF COUNTY AND DISTRICT BOARDS OF HEALTH.**

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**Bill Summary**

The bill specifies that members of a county or district board of health are not allowed to serve concurrently as members of a board of county commissioners and as members of a county or district board of health. The bill also allows members of a county or district board of health to be removed for malfeasance or other specified reasons.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1-508, **add** (7),  
3 (8), and (9) as follows:

4 **25-1-508. County or district boards of public health - public**  
5 **health directors.** (7) MEMBERS OF A COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH OR A  
6 DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH SHALL ATTEND ANNUAL PUBLIC HEALTH  
7 TRAINING PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND  
8 ENVIRONMENT AND DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH  
9 AND ENVIRONMENT ALONG WITH THE COLORADO SCHOOL OF PUBLIC  
10 HEALTH.

11 (8) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT  
12 SHALL PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON RECRUITING PERSONS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE  
13 AND WILLING TO SERVE ON COUNTY AND DISTRICT BOARDS OF HEALTH.  
14 THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT SHALL PROVIDE  
15 THE GUIDANCE IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT TO ANY BOARD OF COUNTY  
16 COMMISSIONERS, COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, OR DISTRICT BOARD OF  
17 HEALTH THAT REQUESTS IT.

18 (9) CHANGES TO THIS SECTION MADE BY HOUSE BILL 21-1115,  
19 ENACTED IN 2021, TAKE EFFECT JANUARY 1, 2022.

20 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
21 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
22 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except  
23 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V  
24 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this  
25 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take  
26 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

- 1 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
