### A BILL FOR AN ACT

### 101 CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE TO SUPPORT

102 **POLLINATORS.** 

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <u>http://leg.colorado.gov</u>.)

The bill creates the support pollinators license plate for vehicles. A person qualifies for issuance of the plate if the person makes a donation to a designated nonprofit organization that supports pollinators. The organization must use the donation for pollination programs and education.

In addition to the normal fees for a license plate, a person must pay

2 additional one-time fees for the issuance of the plate. One of these fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other fee is credited to the licensing services cash fund.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 1 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 42-3-255 as 3 follows: 4 **Special plates - support pollinators.** (1) 42-3-255. THE 5 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES TO QUALIFIED 6 APPLICANTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION FOR MOTORCYCLES, 7 PASSENGER CARS, TRUCKS, OR NONCOMMERCIAL OR RECREATIONAL 8 MOTOR VEHICLES THAT DO NOT EXCEED SIXTEEN THOUSAND POUNDS 9 EMPTY WEIGHT. 10 (2) (a) THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED THE SUPPORT POLLINATORS 11 LICENSE PLATE. 12 (b) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE A DESIGN FROM AN 13 ORGANIZATION THAT MEETS THE STANDARDS OF SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS 14 SECTION, BUT THE DESIGN MUST CONFORM TO DEPARTMENT STANDARDS 15 AND BE APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT. 16 (3) (a) AT LEAST ONCE EVERY FIVE YEARS, THE DEPARTMENT 17 SHALL DESIGNATE AN ORGANIZATION TO QUALIFY APPLICANTS TO BE 18 ISSUED THE SUPPORT POLLINATORS LICENSE PLATE. TO QUALIFY, THE 19 ORGANIZATION MUST: 20 **(I)** BE A STATEWIDE ORGANIZATION HEADQUARTERED IN 21 COLORADO; 22 (II) HAVE BEEN IN EXISTENCE FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS; 23 (III) BE A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION EXEMPT FROM TAXATION; 24 (IV) HELP PROMOTE THE HEALTH OF NATIVE POLLINATORS, WHICH 1 ALSO SUPPORTS THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE;

2 (V) HELP INCREASE NATIVE POLLINATOR HABITAT, INCLUDING
3 SUPPORTING PROTECTIONS FOR POLLINATOR HABITAT AND HEALTH;

4 (VI) HELP EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ABOUT THE VALUE OF NATIVE
5 PLANTS FOR POLLINATORS; AND

6 (VII) HELP FUND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS THAT PROMOTE
7 COLORADO'S POLLINATOR BIODIVERSITY.

8 (b) A PERSON MAY APPLY FOR A SUPPORT POLLINATORS LICENSE 9 PLATE IF THE PERSON PAYS THE TAXES AND FEES REQUIRED UNDER THIS 10 SECTION AND PROVIDES TO THE DEPARTMENT OR AN AUTHORIZED AGENT 11 A CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE ORGANIZATION DESIGNATED IN 12 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION (3) CONFIRMING THAT THE 13 APPLICANT HAS MADE A DONATION TO THE ORGANIZATION. THE 14 ORGANIZATION SHALL USE THE DONATION TO:

15 (I) HELP PROMOTE THE HEALTH OF NATIVE POLLINATORS;

16 (II) HELP INCREASE NATIVE POLLINATOR HABITAT; AND

17 (III) HELP FUND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS THAT PROMOTE18 COLORADO'S NATIVE POLLINATOR BIODIVERSITY.

19 (c) TO QUALIFY APPLICANTS TO HAVE A SUPPORT POLLINATORS
20 LICENSE PLATE, THE ORGANIZATION DESIGNATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH
21 THIS SUBSECTION (3) MUST FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT AN ANNUAL
22 STATEMENT VERIFYING THAT IT IS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

(4) THE AMOUNT OF THE TAXES AND FEES FOR SPECIAL LICENSE
PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION IS THE SAME AS THE AMOUNT OF THE TAXES
AND FEES FOR REGULAR MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES; EXCEPT THAT
THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLECT AN ADDITIONAL ONE-TIME FEE OF
TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FOR ISSUANCE OR REPLACEMENT OF THE LICENSE

PLATE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT THE ADDITIONAL ONE-TIME
 FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE
 HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND CREATED IN SECTION 43-4-201.

4 A PERSON MAY APPLY FOR PERSONALIZED SUPPORT (5) 5 POLLINATORS LICENSE PLATES. UPON PAYMENT OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE 6 REQUIRED BY SECTION 42-3-211 (6)(a) FOR PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE THE PLATES IF THE APPLICANT 7 8 COMPLIES WITH SECTION 42-3-211. IF AN APPLICANT HAS EXISTING 9 PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE, THE APPLICANT 10 MAY TRANSFER THE COMBINATION OF LETTERS OR NUMBERS TO A NEW SET 11 OF SUPPORT POLLINATORS LICENSE PLATES FOR THE VEHICLE UPON PAYING 12 THE FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 42-3-211(6)(a) and upon turning in the 13 EXISTING PLATES TO THE DEPARTMENT. A PERSON WHO HAS OBTAINED 14 PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (5) MUST PAY 15 THE ANNUAL FEE IMPOSED BY SECTION 42-3-211 (6)(b) FOR RENEWAL OF 16 THE PERSONALIZED PLATES. THE FEES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (5) ARE IN 17 ADDITION TO ALL OTHER APPLICABLE TAXES AND FEES.

18 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 42-3-312 as
19 follows:

20 **42-3-312.** Special license plate surcharge. In addition to any 21 other fee imposed by this article 3, an applicant for a special license plate 22 created by rule in accordance with section 42-3-207, as the section existed 23 when the plate was created, or license plates issued pursuant to sections 24 42-3-211 to 42-3-214, sections 42-3-217 to 42-3-218, sections 42-3-221 25 to 42-3-234, and sections 42-3-237 to <del>42-3-254</del> 42-3-255 shall pay an 26 issuance fee of twenty-five dollars; except that the fee is not imposed on 27 special license plates exempted from additional fees for the issuance of a military special license plate by section 42-3-213 (1)(b)(II). The
department shall transfer the fee to the state treasurer, who shall credit it
to the licensing services cash fund created in section 42-2-114.5.

4 SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 5 6 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 7 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 8 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 9 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 10 11 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 12 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
