This bill allows a local governing body to vote to reject or modify a health order. Local governments that choose to vote on such a matter will have an increase in expenditures.

## Summary of Legislation

This bill allows a local governing body to vote to reject or modify a health order issued by a county or district public health agency, public health director, or board of health.

## Local Government

Local governments that choose to consider rejecting or modifying a public health order will have an increase in expenditures to hold a hearing and vote.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
